Representative Teams

We have five representative teams in various competitions at the city and provincial levels. Each team built their skills and confidence. Managers worked to find teams at a similar playing level as their own teams, and engaged them in friendly games. These were very much appreciated by all children gaining valuable skills. The team record of 15 wins and 7 loses culminated with the bronze medal in division 11 at the Ontario Cup.




Congratulations to our past members

Financial Statement

Troyka's Board of Directors approved the financial statements for the fiscal year of 2017/2018 on October 6, 2018. The approved statement was shared with all the membership. We had \$63,875 revenue and \$63,111 of expenses. The surplus was \$763 and it was allocated to the education of the volunteer coaches.

For the 2018/19 FY we plan on having \$75,600 revenue and \$75,537 of expenses. The Financial plan directly correlates income with the club expenses. Revenue and expenses increase is related to additional REP teams. Financial responsibility and balanced budget will continue to be our strategic priority.
